COURSE SELECTION

- ℓ Provisional course list sent with application documents.
- Confirmation upon arrival during the orientation days. The choice of courses is <u>binding</u> and cannot be modified after the 1st two weeks of the semester.
- √ Courses are credited with grades and ECTS credits.
- Courses generally offer 30-36 hours of lecture and require 54 or 108 hours of autonomous course work per semester.
- On average 7 to 8 courses per week (around 20 hours per week) are necessary to validate 30 ECTS in one semester.
- ${\cal C}$ The course selection depends on the requirements of each home institution.
- 4 Sandwich or study work courses is a possible option for degreeseeking graduate students ONLY.
- It is not possible to choose courses from different programs.
